## **BACHELOR'S PROGRAM IN BIOECONOMY - HOW TO APPLY**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Application period for the Winter Semester: 15 May – 15 July

### **STEPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL APPLICATION**

1. To apply, please complete the application form via TUMonline:  
<http://campus.tum.de>
2. If you did not have a German Higher Education Entrance Qualification (more information: [Higher Education Entrance Qualification - TUM](#)), you will need to apply via **Uni-Assist** in addition. Please note that the application deadline applies for the Uni-Assist application as well. However, the VPD document can be handed in later:

3. Once you have completed the online application form, you will receive a list of all documents that you need to upload along with a signed version of your completed application form. This list of documents you will need to submit will include the following:
  - Signed application form (form provided in TUMonline)
  - Higher Education Entrance Qualification
  - Resume / Curriculum Vitae (gap-free), passport or ID (copy)
  - For admissions from non-EU/EEC countries: preliminary documentation by uni-assist ([Uni-Assist - TUM](#))
  - Aptitude recommendation (SOV) Participation Confirmation Form

4. After uploading the necessary documents, your application will be processed and evaluated by various departments.

**Please note that if an applicant does not meet the entrance requirements at the time of application no conditional admission will be given!**

## **APTITUDE RECOMMENDATION (SOV) - INFORMATION**

As an additional document, you must upload the “Participation Confirmation Form” from the completed online test.

**Please note** that the result of the online test has no impact on your potential admission. However, participation in the test – and thus the corresponding proof – is a required part of the complete application. The test is conducted via the learning platform “Moodle”. You will receive access and further instructions during your application process. Once you have access, you can take the test at a time that suits you best.

**The test** takes approximately 15 minutes and consists of 10 to 20 questions in English. The questions cover the following areas:

- Content and structure of the Bachelor's program in Bioeconomy
- Mathematics and natural sciences
- Basics of Economics and social science

The questions do not exceed the level of general secondary school education. Please note that the result of the online test does not affect your eligibility for admission to the Bachelor's program. The test is simply designed to help you get a better sense of the program's content and whether it aligns with your interests.
